State Fiscal Year 2026 Funding Opportunity

Northwestern Illinois Area Agency on Aging (NIAAA) is soliciting Letters of Interest from non-profit and local government organizations qualified to receive Federal/State of Illinois financial assistance grants to provide services for older adults (age 60+) as authorized under the Older Americans Act of 1965 (Public Law 89-73) in its 9-county Planning and Service Area consisting of Boone, Carroll, DeKalb, Jo Daviess, Lee, Ogle, Stephenson, Whiteside and Winnebago counties.

The funding period runs from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026 with an option to extend the contract for an additional two years.

Fundable services include:

- Adult Protective Services

Adult Protective Services (APS) is a social services program to support older adults and adults with disabilities experiencing abuse, neglect, self-neglect, or financial exploitation. APS programs investigate reports of maltreatment; provide support and, in some cases, case-management; and connect those facing abuse to a variety of protective, emergency, and support services.

The service provider must adhere to NIAAA's General Service Requirements.

Successful applicants must comply with all applicable pre-qualification requirements including, but not limited to, current DUNS and SAM numbers, acceptable fiscal management/fiscal stability (including the ability to meet matching requirements), are in good standing with the Secretary of State and are not on any Debarred/Suspended/Stop Payment/Excluded Parties listings.
